Addendum to Rental Agreement Page 3

Welcome to ALTMANS WINNEBAGO. We hope that your upcoming trip in our motor home will be a delightful experience for you and your traveling party. To assist you in preparing for your departure, we have listed some helpful information and facts. Please read it carefully and sign at the bottom to signify that you are aware of and agree to these important terms.

Weight Limits

All vehicles have a weight limit established by the chassis manufacturer. You should always be careful not to exceed the GVWR (Gross Vehicle Weight Rating) of the vehicle. Traveling with full fuel, water, and waste tanks makes the vehicle quite heavy and cuts down on the carrying capacity of people, personal items, food, and luggage. It also affects fuel economy. If you have any questions regarding weight, please consult our personnel or check the weight label found in the wardrobe.

Engine And Generator Fluids

It is important that you check the engine fluids, especially oil, every time you stop to refuel. If the vehicle needs any fluids, please add the proper amount. You will be reimbursed when you present us with the receipt upon your return. Driving with low fluid levels can cause engine damage for which you are totally responsible. It is important that you watch all gauges; driving the vehicle while it is overheated will cause engine damage. It is also vital that you check the generator fluid level every 6-8 hours of operation. If the generator or the engine needs oil, you may use 30Wt or 10w30 oil, available at any service station.

Damage

Be sure and watch for low hanging branches, canopies at gas stations and fast-food restaurants, and parking structures. Damage above the windshield and below the bumper as well as collisions off public highways is the most common and expensive we generally see. Also, be certain you replace the entrance step before traveling.

Seat Belts And Air Bags

Seat belts are provided in various seats around the vehicle. It is very important, both for your safety and to abide by state and federal laws, that they be worn whenever the vehicle is in motion. Type C motor homes are equipped with driver and passenger supplemental restraint systems (air bags) and care should be taken when choosing small individuals (especially children) to occupy those seats.

Hitch use

You are not permitted to tow anything with our vehicle nor use the hitch to hold bike racks or similar type items unless we install them and we have given specific written permission to you on page 1 of your rental agreement.

Accidents

If you are involved in an accident of any kind, it is your responsibility to report it to us. You will need to fill out an INCIDENT REPORT found in your operations guide before your security deposit is returned to you. In addition, if the damage exceeds \$500, the vehicle is involved in a hit-and-run situation, or there are any injuries, you must report the incident to the police.

Limitations of Livability Systems

It is vital for you to note that this is a camping and convenience vehicle. We expressly DO NOT warrant that the comfort and convenience items will always function and that you should never travel to places where those items are required for survival. An example would be traveling with passengers who's health depends on the heating or air conditioning systems functioning properly and extreme cold or hot temperatures would endanger their well being.

Return time

It is our policy to provide our customers with on-time service. To accomplish this, we need the cooperation of our renters to return the motor home at the prescribed return time. Late returns may cause delays in checking you in. You should allow a minimum of 45 minutes for returning the vehicle and more if the vehicle has been damaged. Any returns after 11:00am will be considered late and charged accordingly.

Unless specifically scheduled, you may only return the vehicle Monday through Friday. To assure compliance, it is necessary for us to assess a late fee of \$50 per hour or \$300 per day plus additional nightly fees. Vehicles returned after 4:00 will be charged for that night as well as any late fees.

Early returns

Due to our advanced booking procedures, we are not able to refund any portion of your rental fee if you return prior to your scheduled return date, regardless of reason.

Extensions

Extending your vacation is possible but not guaranteed. You must ask permission prior to your return date and the additional nights must be paid for (usually by the credit card on file) before the extension is effective. Extensions cannot be granted to include weekend or holiday returns.
